

LESSON TWO

Cherubim & Ark of the Covenant

BEFORE CLASS

Complete Bible study for lesson two pg. 15. If you have purchased *Rose Book of Bible charts, Maps & Timelines*, the pages I used for this class are 147, 152, 153, 154 and 155. You can legally make photocopies for your class. If photocopies are not available, hold up the pages or pass around so everyone can see. If you did not purchase the book, look for photos online of the Ark of the Covenant and Tabernacle that you could show.

SECOND CLASS BEGINS

WELCOME

Be friendly. Attendance Keep track of people from your class. If students miss; ask others where they are or check up on them if they miss more than a couple classes.

Assign volunteers (before class begins) to be ready to read the verses with the * questions when they come up in class. *10 (pg. 18)

REVIEW QUESTIONS FROM LESSON ONE

Ask these questions and let the students answer. If it has been awhile they may need help. Review questions are great to get the previous lesson information more ingrained in your brain. I do not write these on the board I just ask the questions and the students shout out the answers. Give positive feedback to your students like; great job, that is correct, what else do you remember...

1. Who made all things? God through Jesus for God. This means angels were also created.

2. What did you learn about the appearance of angels? Mighty, moved stone, sat upon stone, look like lightning, had clothing (were not naked), like dazzling snow, flaming fire, winds, could fly swiftly with wings, wings of wind, could eat

3. Where did the angels come from? Descended from heaven.

4. What was manna called? Bread of angels

5. Why should we show hospitality to strangers? We may entertain angels without knowing it.

SHARE AND CARE QUESTION (pg 15)

Share your name and answer the question or pass.

Where do you usually hear God talking to you?

This could be a place or time of day that you usually pray.

PRAYER

Use your own prayer or the one below.

Dear Lord,

Dear Lord, Thanks for bringing us together again to study your Word. Teach us what you want us to know. Help us hear your voice and to obey like angels do. Because there is sin in the world we need your forgiveness. Thanks for sending your Son Jesus to die for our sins. We want to eat from the tree of life and have everlasting life. ADDED INFORMATION

Read the scripture aloud one verse at a time around the table, letting all who would like to read participate or pass.

Cherubim are celestial beings (angels) with wings that guard. Cherub is singular.

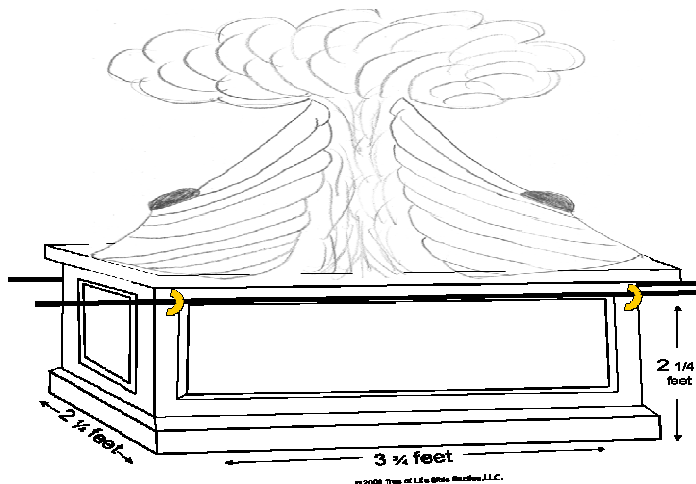
1. a. This is the tree that Adam and Eve ate from **Genesis 2:17** but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat from it you shall surely die.

c. God clothed Adam and Eve and it was the first bloodshed.

d. Adam and Eve now knew good and evil. As believers we also know what is good and evil.

e. If they ate from the tree of life they could live forever.

2. g. Show photo from **Rose Book of Bible Charts, Maps & Time Lines** use pages 152-154. Read about the Ark of the Covenant and the Mercy Seat on page 154.

3. c. 1. golden jar of manna (we learned last lesson that manna was bread of angels)

2. Aaron's rod, budded

3. Table of the covenant (10 commandments found in Exodus 20)
