FOCUS ON THE FACTS

God and Jesus were in the beginning. All things were created in the heavens and earth, visible and invisible. They were created through Him and for Him. Even though the Scriptures do not specifically state when angels were created, we know that they were created! The angel seen at Jesus' tomb descended from heaven (after a severe earthquake), rolled away the stone and sat upon it. His appearance was like lightning and his clothing was white as snow. The guards were afraid and fell like dead men. The angels in Luke suddenly appeared and had dazzling clothing. Angels are also described as mighty in flaming fire or like wind. Some angels came in human form and others came flying swiftly. Two angels appeared to Abraham and Lot and they ate with them. In Psalms we found out that manna came from heaven, the bread of angels. We should show hospitality to strangers because we may be entertaining angels without knowing it.
